Margery Gordon Obituary

Margery Elvis Lynch Gordon, 75, of Avila Beach died Tuesday, Oct. 22, 2002, at a San Diego hospital. Mrs. Gordon was born Nov. 14, 1926, in Louisville, Ky., to Rose Sheinberg Lynch and Jack Lynch. She graduated from Atherton High School and attended the University of Miami in Coral Gables, Fla., where she was a member of Delta Phi Epsilon sorority. Margery married Dr. Harold N. Gordon on March 7, 1947, in Louisville. The couple lived in Yuma, Ari., from 1952 to 1971, where Margery managed

the office of her husband's medical practice In Yuma, Margery served as chairman of the City of Hope Mother's March; president of the Yuma County Junior Women's Club; state board member of Arizona Junior Women's Club; an officer in Yuma Little Theater; president of Yuma County Humane Society; co-director of the Yuma County Humane Society Telethon; Campfire Girl leader for two troops; and was selected "Man" of the Month by a local television station. Margery resided in Phoenix from 1972 to 1985 where she worked as Director of Scheduling for Woodard Junior High School and as a travel agent until her retirement in 1983. Margery moved to San Luis Bay Estates in Avila Beach in Aug. 1985 and served as president of the Indian Hills Women's Club, led a water aerobics group and loved making porcelain dolls. Margery is survived by her children, Dale Gordon of Ventura; Robyn Metchik and husband, Paul of Arroyo Grande; Wendy Garner and husband, Sanders of Danville; Kendall Marshall of Bakersfield; Dr. Josh Gordon and wife, Elizabeth of San Diego; brothers, Bert Lynch and wife, Shirley of Greensboro, N.C.; Maury Lynch and wife, Eileen of West Palm Beach, Fla.; sister-in-law, Joan Lynch of Louisville; and grandchildren, Aaron; Ariana; and Asher Metchik; Jospeh; David; and Michael Garner; Heidi and Tammy Gross; Garrett Marshall; and Adam and Rachel Gordon.
