

MISS FANNIE HAAS DEAD; RESIDENT OF DULUTH 30 YEARS

Miss Fannie Haas, age 57, a resident of this city for over 30 years and well known in spite of having been an invalid all her life, died at St. Mary's hospital Tuesday. While in Duluth she made her home with her sister, Mrs. P. H. Oswald, who died a few years ago. Since then Miss Haas had lived at Rice Lake with another sister, Mrs. S. Manhalm.

Miss Haas' condition has been so serious that she had been at the hospital since last September. Mrs. Manhalm was with her at the time of her death. The funeral will be held at Crawford's undertaking rooms at 1:30 o'clock this afternoon and at 2 o'clock from Temple Emanuel, Second street and Seventh avenue East. Interment will be in the Jewish cemetery at Woodland.
