Bernard Richard Mazursky was the son of Mrs. Rose Mazursky, 314 S. Orchard St., Madison, Wisconsin. He graduated from Madison, Wisconsin's Central-University High School in 1966 and was a member of Beth Israel Center.

Bernard enlisted in the US Army and was a Specialist Fourth Class. He began his enlistment on December 1, 1966. He was assigned to the 4th Infantry Division, Light Weapons Infantry. He was in Madison in about April 1968 while his unit was being transferred from Germany to Vietnam.

One month later, Spec. Mazursky was killed in action in South Vietman on May 4, 1968.

Surviving besides his mother were three brothers, Marvin of Madison, Larry of Tarzana, Calif; and Charles of San Francisco; and two sisters, Linda and Beverly, of Madison.
