Benjamin Wilk, 82, Building Firm Head

Services for Benjamin Wilk, founder and president of the Standard Building Products Co., will be at 1 p.m. Sunday at Temple Beth El, Woodward and Gladstone, with arrangements by the Ira Kaufman Funeral Home, 18325 W. Nine Mile, Southfield.

Mr. Wilk, 82, died Thursday in his Detroit home. A native of Minneapolis, he had lived in Detroit for 50 years. He founded the company in 1926. He was an engineering graduate of the University of Minnesota.

He was a member of the board of governors of the Technion Society of Israel and a member of the syndicate which built the Rock Products Plant in Israel.

Mr. Wilk was president of the National Concrete Masonry Association and of the Concrete Association of Michigan. He was past chairman of the Religious School Committee and a member of the Allied Jewish Campaign and the American Jewish Committee.
