

Ex-Cass County Legislator Dies

FARGO (AP) — Mortimer A. Wilk, 67, Fargo, died unexpectedly in his home Friday. He was a former member of the North Dakota Legislature, serving in the House from 1951 to 1953.

Wilk was president of the Interstate Seed & Grain Co., here, and a director of the First Bankstock Equity Corp.

A former president of the Fargo Chamber of Commerce, he was also president of the West Fargo Elevator Co.; president of the Twin City Seed Co. of Minneapolis; a director of Pride Hybrid Co., Dassel, Minn., and a director of Western Grain Co., Bismarck.

Wilk was born in Beaver Dam, Wis., and moved to Moorhead, Minn., with his family when a boy. He attended Fargo college and Columbia University before entering military service in World War I.

After the war he entered business with his father in Fargo.

Survivors include his widow and two daughters.
