

REV. JOSEPH WOLFE DIES

Cantor of Temple Israel for
30 Years Was 67

The Rev. Joseph E. Wolfe, for thirty years cantor of Temple Israel, 210 West Ninety-first Street, died Thursday in Manhattan General Hospital. He was 67 years old.

Cantor Wolfe went to Temple Israel in 1927 and remained there in that capacity until his retirement in 1956, when he was elected cantor emeritus.

Born in Russia, he received his cantorial training in that country. Cantor Wolfe also studied under Enrico Caruso and for many years he appeared on concert stage.

Cantor Wolfe had tutored singers in a number of the leading choirs here. He was a member of the Ministers Cantors Association of America.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Bernice Barnhard of Washington; Mrs. Geraldine Freidel of Lawrence, L. I., and Miss Marcella Wolfe of this city, and five grandchildren.
