

New York Rabbi May Succeed Lebendiger

Rabbi David Aaronson, New York City, will arrive in Duluth Saturday at the invitation of the board of directors of the Duluth Hebrew Institute, which is considering several applicants to succeed Rabbi Israel Lebendiger, who has resigned.

Rabbi Lebendiger is expected to leave Nov. 7 or 8 for St. Louis, where he will assume charge of the Shaare Zedek synagogue. He has been in charge of the Hebrew Institute Sunday school and congregation during the last two years.

For several years Rabbi Aaronson was in charge of the synagogue at Salt Lake City, Utah. During the war he was chaplain associated with the Jewish welfare board.
