Text from 1895-5-9 newspaper article of the fire on St. Croix Avenue:

"At the north end of the block to one story building occupied by H. Hill's grocery store formed a fort for the firemen and the flames were stopped there, but not until the building had suffered considerable damage. At the south end of the block the fire was gotten under control after it had partly destroyed a tenement house, 362 St. Croix Avenue, owned by Mayor Truelsen. The fire burned fiercely for more than two hours, and it was not until after 5 o'clock that it was fully under control, and even after that the firemen remained and poured water on the burning ruins."
