

## CIVIL ACTIONS.

### Cases Begun and Orders Made Yesterday In District Court.

Judge Lewis yesterday sustained the defendant's demurrer, in the case of Robert L. Wilkins against William C. Sherwood, on the grounds that the complaint did not state grounds sufficient to constitute a cause of action.

In the matter of the assignment of James T. Smith an order was issued yesterday for the creditors to appear at the court house June 9, and show cause why the insolvent estate should not be sold by the assignee.

The appointment of W. F. Lardner as the receiver for the United States Loan and Investment Co. was confirmed yesterday by an order of Judge Moer.

An order was made by Judge Lewis yesterday discharging the assignee of Isaac Summerfield.

An order to sell in gross was made in the matter of the assignment of C. P. Oswald.

A motion for a new trial has been denied in the case of G. D. Sheldon against H. H. Richards.

The personal injury case of W. N. Edmondson against Oppel & Sons was heard yesterday before Judge Ensign. The case was submitted.
