

INDICTED AT DULUTH

The County Registrar Before the Bar
of Justice.

Duluth, Minn., Feb. 2.—Two of the four indictments returned by the grand jury on Saturday were made public to-day.

P. J. Borgstrom, register of deeds of St. Louis county was brought before the court, charged with misappropriating county funds to the amount of \$325. He is accused of making certified copies of instruments and failing to turn the money over to the county. He was given one day to plead and his bond was fixed at \$1,000.

Another indictment was against four men, Moses Cook, Isaac Abrahamson, Helmer Cohen and W. M. Abrahamson. They are charged with conspiracy. Finch, VanBlyke & Young of St. Paul are at the bottom of the matter. Cook is charged with buying goods and turning them over to the others, afterward failing and having scarcely any assets. The amount of goods bought was about \$17,000. This was in 1896. They were arraigned and held to plead Friday, with bail fixed at \$500 each.
