

NEW HEBREW SYNAGOGUE.

Kofereth Congregation Buys Building for Place of Worship.

The Kofereth Israel congregation has purchased the easterly half of lot 59, East Fifth street. The society is remodelling the building on the premises into a synagogue, and it will be provided with all the necessary equip-

ments for Hebrew worship, according to all the forms of this ancient religion. It will be the first church of the kind in the city. The Hebrews, who constitute a considerable portion of the population of Duluth are congratulating themselves on having obtained a permanent church home.

The society has been regularly incorporated under the laws of the state of Minnesota. The officers are as follows: President, Jacob Levine; secretary and treasurer, Joseph Oreckovsky; trustees, Henry Caploiv, Joseph Oreckovsky, William Goldstein and Isedra Lieberman. The society has a membership of 100 all active.
