

LINDSAY THE LOCATER.

**He Will Have His Examination July
Eighth.**

Daniel C. Lindsay, the alleged ore locator, who was brought back from

Minneapolis Sunday on complaint of Attorney Theodore Hollister, who charged him with defrauding him of \$65, was arraigned in police court yesterday. Lindsay's alleged offense is classed as grand larceny in the second degree, and precludes him from pleading except in the district court. His examination was set for July 8, at 2 o'clock, and in default of \$500 bail he was committed to the county jail. Baldwin & Baldwin are his attorneys.

Young David Azinsky was tried on the charge of stealing Ed. Haugsjaa's hat, and, as it developed that it was more a case of mischief than wilfull larceny, the boy was discharged on payment of witness fees.

Belle Higgins was sent to the county jail for 30 days for drunkenness.
