

2 MORE NEW HOMES ON HAMMOND AVE.

Messrs. Siegel Bros. Will Begin Building as Soon as Weather Permits.

The immediate vicinity of the public library continues to be the desirable residence portion of the city, and every day real estate men are receiving inquiries for lots. Yesterday Michael M. Lynch, with offices in Breunig building, sold three lots at the northeast corner of Clark street and Hammond avenue, to Aaron and Elias Siegel, clothiers, Fourteenth street.
