

SHAPIRO ASKS FOR NEW TRIAL

Eveleth Man Would Recover Money Paid Out on a Lien.

Max P. Shapiro, of Eveleth, has filed notice of a motion for a new trial in the suit begun by him in district court against H. C. Burchell and others to recover money paid out on a lien. The case was tried a few days ago before Judge Cant, and the jury returned a verdict in favor of the defendant.

The claim is made in the motion that the verdict of the jury was not warranted by the evidence and is contrary to law, and that there are errors in the ruling of the court.

Shapiro built a store building at Eveleth for Burchell and the other defendants in the action, and it was attached by the Paine & Nixon company for some material furnished the defendants.

Shapiro was compelled to pay the amount, and he sued to recover it.
