

# CHISHOLM STORES ARE BURGLARIZED

CHISHOLM, OCTOBER 6.—

Burglars last night broke into the saloon of Simon Sapero and the clothing store of Sax & Cohen. Entrance to both places was gained in the same manner through a rear window, the glass of which had been clearly removed.

The burglars did not secure anything at Saperos, unless it was whiskey from the barrel as everything was found in its place this morning. It is thought they were frightened away before they could finish operations as the slot machine would have netted them a large sum had they been tapped.

Sax & Cohen did not fare so well as the burglars secured booty in the way of clothing, furnishing and shoes.

Neither Mr. Sax nor Mr. Cohen knows at this time the extent of their loss but they are of the opinion that it will be considerable.

When the store was opened this morning the rear door was found unlocked and goods scattered in all directions. There is no clue to the burglars but the police have the matter in hand and are hopeful of securing the guilty parties.
