

MANY OBJECT TO SCHOOL SITE

Considerable objection is being made to the new school building site on the Fayal road, recently offered by the steel corporation. Several prominent citizens have conferred with members of the school board and a great deal of general discussion has resulted from the conference.

The site offered is separated from the Fayal school by only the block on which the Presbyterian church is located. The citizens say that the right place for the school is farther north on the hill, where it will appear to better advantage and be nearer the center of the city.

It is understood that the free offer of the steel corporation has had the effect of scaling down considerably the price asked by other owners.

The Fayal road site is very near the mine and the time might come when caves would surround the school. Drifts are very close to, if not actually underneath the road.

The new building is to be an expensive and permanent one and should be placed on a suitable site.
