

RABBI SILBER IS RE-ELECTED

The congregation of Temple Emmanuel has re-elected Rabbi Mendel Silber for another year at a largely increased salary. He will leave on Tuesday for Philadelphia, Pa., where he will preach the opening sermon at the Israel Synagogue of the annual National Jewish convention and goes

from there to New York City, where he will superintend the publication of a work which he has written. It is a treatise on the topic of world wide interest, "The Jewish Renaissance." Dr. Silber has spent much of his time during the past year on the book and takes a reasonable pride in the completeness with which he has covered his subject. He has dealt with every phase of the question and the work has required a minute and broad research.

The weekly services at the temple closed yesterday when the rite of confirmation was conferred upon a large class. Services will be resumed Sep. 1.
