

RAISE MONEY FOR JEWS AT VIRGINIA

VIRGINIA, NOV. 26.—

H. J. Nathanson and J. Roman have undertaken the work of receiving subscriptions in this city for the relief of the oppressed Jews in Russia. They have received liberal amounts from Hebrew residents and others, and the sum collected has now reached very nearly \$100. The list is still open to all who wish to contribute. The money will be sent to Banker Jacob Scheiff, of New York, for delivery to the proper persons in Russia.
