

# KROJANKER IS BANKRUPT

Furrier Files Petition In Federal Court Placing Liabilities at \$20,248.28.

---

Robert Krojanker, the well known Superior street furrier, filed a petition in voluntary bankruptcy in the office of the clerk of the United States district court yesterday afternoon. The total liabilities amount to \$20,248.28, the assets being given as \$14,226.95.

Mr. Krojanker has been in business in Duluth for a number of years, and was believed to be doing a profitable business. His assignment is a surprise in business circles.

The liabilities consist of taxes for street improvements to the amount of \$1,070.39 and wages to his employes, \$70.07, on which the workmen and the city will secure payment in full, taking precedence above all other creditors. Other creditors hold securities to the amount of \$9,300, and those with unsecured claims foot up a total of \$8,607.82, consisting of debts contracted in the ordinary course of business.

The assets consist of real estate to the value of \$12,086, including the homestead property in Duluth and considerable personal property which is exempt from seizure by creditors. The stock and machinery are valued at \$2,145.95.
