

MARCOVITCH WILL LEAVE SUPERIOR

N. Marcovitch, principal of the Hebrew night school in Superior has tendered his resignation to the directors of the school to take effect March 21. Mr. Marcovitch said to the News Tribune:

"I have not fully decided on plans for the future but will probably return to one of the eastern cities and resume my profession as a teacher."

Mr. Marcovitch will study for the Hebrew priesthood and is anxious to secure employment in one of the larger cities, in order that he might take up his duties. He has been in charge of the Superior school for seven months during which time it has made wonderful advancement under his tutorage.

On March 16 he will deliver a lecture on Judaism to the Jewish girls of Superior and on the following day will address the parents on the same subject. The directors of the school will meet Sunday to take action towards securing his successor.
