

POLINSKY TO TEST ORDINANCE IN COURT

C. M. Polinsky, of Duluth, is under arrest on the charge of violating the village ordinance regulating the licensing of peddlers, auctioneers and other transient dealers. Polinsky opened a bankrupt stock of clothing in the town Saturday. The village marshal informed him that he would be required to pay a license fee of \$15 a day. He refused to do this and his arrest followed. The trial has been set for Tuesday. Polinsky is of the opinion that the ordinance is unconstitutional and is determined to fight the case.
