

# DRAWS REVOLVER ON OFFENDER

William Kaner, on his plea of guilty, was fined \$5 and costs in municipal court yesterday for resisting Policeman O'Neill of Chester park. Kaner, it is claimed, was driving cows along the side of the park, when some of the animals broke away from the herd and ran into the grove. Policeman O'Neill started after them, but Kaner's son drove them away and Kaner is claimed to have attacked the officer, who drew his revolver in self defense. Kaner says the policeman told him he would shoot him in the legs if he did not obey his order to stop. Judge Cutting stated to the officer in court that the use of a weapon on a misdemeanor charge was not to be countenanced.
