KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together and agree upon the following Articles of Incorporation under the provisions of Chapter 25, General Laws of the State of Minnesota, for the year 1876, and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, and do hereby adopt the following articles:

**ARTICLE I.**
