

# SENIOR CLASS PLAY IS BEAUTIFULLY ENACTED

Fine Presentation of Pretty Comedy Witnessed by Large and Approving Audience—Oration and Unusual Program Meritorious. Grade Graduations Will Begin Today.

Boomer! Boomer!  
Rah Rah Rix!  
Duluth Central High school 1906!  
Again and repeat.  
Thirty or more lusty seniors of the Central High school last night capped the class play, "The Great Catastrophe," with a yelling act in the corridors. Time and again they yelled with a will, and each time they were answered by the freshmen, sophomores, juniors or alumni.

The walls, echoed the commingled cries and measured tramp of feet, arousing class rivalry. When the excitement was at its height the band of freshmen and sophomores rushed the juniors and seniors with all the vigor of strong young manhood. Hundreds of elderly men and women were leaving the building when the rush began, but the hurried to safe corners and smiled their approval of the lively demonstration. Their attitude bore out the principal that the young must have their day.

The little comedy of two acts was as refreshing to the large audience—and every seat in the auditorium was taken—as is any change from routine life. It is true the stage is too small for the audience at sharp angles to see, but all heard and appreciated the players just entering the stage of serious life.

**Actors Do Good Work.**  
The setting of a real theater was lacking, but not so the spirit of the actors. They read their lines intelligently, and in the happy climax love claimed its own. Winsome Violet and Jack triumphed over paternal objection to their marriage; mincing Tillie gave her heart to Benjamin, relieving his anxiety, and Robert made Dorothea, nervous but love-lorn, happy by asking her to be his wife. Only Dennis Milliken, who caused the catastrophe, by foolishly believing Tillie's playful story that he had murdered an umbrella mender by pushing him off the porch, was left without a mate. But he got the money to bring his Catherine over from Ireland, so he was happy with the rest when the entanglements were made straight.

**Reviews Nation's Growth.**  
Benjamin Frink, class orator, reviewed the growth of the nation and expressed great faith in the patriotism of its millions; to slay the trust bugs and give labor its just reward. To quell a threatened social uprising, blend the interests of all classes and enforce justice is, he declared, "The Mission of True Americanism."

Edwin Borgen, president of the seniors, spoke in behalf of the class, which sang "The Class of 1906" and "The Yang Tee-Liang." Alice Sjostedt '07, was much applauded in her solos; "I Know a Bank" and "Stolen Wings."

The class play marks an epoch in the history of the 30,000 seniors whose last week of high school life is fraught with pleasant memories.
