CLOSES FOR SEASON

Dr. Mendel Silber Delivers an Eloquent Sermon.

At the closing service of the season at Temple Emanu El last night, Dr. Mendel Silber gave an address from the text, "As the days of the tree are the days of my people and the work of their hands my elect shall carry out."

Dr. Silber referred to the history of Judaism and the marvelous manner in which the nation had been preserved through countless difficulties. The growth and preservation of the race he compared to the development of the mighty oak from the life germ in the tiny acorn.
