

PRESENTATION IS CELEBRATED

Officers of New Russian Jewish
Synagogue Are Also Chosen
For Year.

Members of the new Russian-Jewish synagogue last evening celebrated the presentation made by the members of the Ladies' Benevolent Hebrew Charity association of the Holy Script of the Mosaic law and elected officers. The ceremonies were very impressive and largely attended. The holy script is printed on calfskin and is imported from Russia. It is considered very sacred, and if allowed to fall on the floor the whole congregation is forced to fast for a certain period. Rabbi Teplitz read portions of the Script in Hebrew.

The congregation has purchased the church formerly occupied by the Swedish Lutherans and will make extensive improvements in the building. Regular services will be held in the near future.
