

SAYS CONTRACT WAS NOT ADHERED TO

J. M. Oreckovsky Brings Suit Against Moir & Walker Over Sale of Clothing Stock.

Claiming that Moir & Walker, clothiers of the West End, have refused to sell him a part of their stock of merchandise for 70 per cent. of the actual cost, as agreed, and have kept his earnest money, \$200, Joseph M. Oreckovsky yesterday started suit against them in district court for \$200 judgment.

The plaintiff swears that Aug. 8 he made a contract with the defendants to buy goods for 70 per cent. of the cost price. He swears that after he paid the money to bind the bargain, the defendants made the cost marks on the goods higher.
