

FELL DOWN STAIRS; SUES FOR DAMAGE

**Golda Sosnovsky Wants \$1,000
Because of Injuries Sustained
at Fox's Hardware Store.**

Joseph E. Fox and his wife, Lucille, have been made the defendants in a suit for \$1,000 damages brought by Golda Sosnovsky. The complaint was filed yesterday in the office of the clerk of the district court.

The complaint states that the plaintiff was in the hardware store owned by the defendant and in her examination of goods which she intended to buy, she was compelled to walk around the store. She claims that there is a hatchway leading into the cellar and this opening was unguarded at the time she was there. The defendant called her attention to some goods which caused her to step back and in doing so she fell down the stairway. She claims to have rolled several feet and sustained injuries to her back, hips and shoulder. She claims to have paid out \$25 for medical treatment and she asks for that amount in addition to the \$1,000 which she asks for the pain she says she endured.
