

# FORMER JUSTICES USE THE STRONG RIGHT ARM

EVELETH, July 26.—Louis Finn, one time justice of peace at Ashland, Wis., resented what he took to be a personal affront, when Isaac Goldstein was seen to walk up the street with Finn's divorced wife. The two met on the corner soon after and damaged each other seriously in a fistic encounter. They were arrested, and each released on ball.

Goldstein, who was also once upon a time a justice of peace in a Wisconsin town, desired to invoke his knowledge of the law against his enemy, and swore out a warrant for Finn's arrest.

He was taken into custody at Virginia, and removed today to the jail at Eveleth.
