

JEWISH LODGE O. B. A. TO BE INSTITUTED AT EVELETH

EVELETH, March 18.—A preliminary organization of the Jewish Benevolent and Fraternal Order, O. B. A., has been effected in Eveleth and steps will be taken to perfect the organization and make it one of the permanent lodges of the city.

At a meeting held in the Jewish synagogue, on Jackson street, S. Sax was elected temporary president; H. G. Perlman, vice president; Sam Siegel, secretary, and Jacob Stein, treasurer.

The O. B. A. receives members of both sexes into membership, a man and wife being considered a unit. Single men are also received. There is an insurance of \$500 at a reasonable rate.

The order is strong in most Jewish communities, but so far there is only one lodge on the range, that at Hibbing, which is large and influential. It is expected that the Eveleth lodge will embrace membership of Jewish people in the towns to the east.
