

# YOUNG MAN JAILED; FORGERY ALLEGED

**Bernard Springer Arrested at  
Eveleth, Accused of Passing  
a Bogus Check.**

EVELETH, Minn., April 8.—Bernard Springer, a young man of this place, was arrested this morning on the charge of forging a check. This is the second charge of a similar nature preferred against him.

It is alleged that he purchased a suit of clothes at A. E. Perlman's store for \$12 and tendered a check made out to J. Springer on the Biwabik bank and drawn by Wm. Brennan in payment. Mr. Perlman grew suspicious and called up the bank at Biwabik. He was informed that Brennan had no deposit at the bank. Chief of police Kent arrested Springer and he is lodged in the city jail awaiting a hearing.

Young Springer has paid the amount of the check and requested his release.

Springer was married about a month ago to one of Eveleth's charming young women.
