

VIRGINIA JEWS BUILD SYNAGOGUE

Bnai Abraham Congregation Begins Work on New \$10,000 Building.

VIRGINIA, Oct. 30.—The local Jewish society, known as the Bnai Abraham, has completed financial arrangements for the completion of the new synagogue to be erected at the corner of Locust street and Cleveland avenue. The excavation for the building is already completed and work on the foundation walls has begun. The building will be completed and furnished at a cost of about \$10,000 and will provide a home for the Jewish congregation.
