

WOMAN ARRESTED AT CLOQUET FOR THEFT

CLOQUET, Minn., Dec. 13.—A woman calling herself Margaret McIntosh was arrested in the Companies' store on a charge of petty larceny, preferred against her by the firm where she was arrested and also by the B. J. Summerfield Dry Goods Co., and the L. A. Fish Hardware Co.

Suspicion against her was aroused five days ago and following her arrest merchandise from the above firms was found in her room at the Hotel Cloquet to the amount of about \$60, consisting of furs, fine china, kid gloves, silk mufflers and smaller articles in value. She also sent away by express a package weighing six pounds. She was brought before Municipal Judge W. H. Skemp and given a sentence of 25 days in the county jail or \$25, and the fine not being paid she was taken to Carlton to serve the term. She is a stranger in the city.
