

CHARITIES FARE WELL BY J. D. ZIEN'S WILL

Charities were important beneficiaries in the will of J. D. Zien, which was filed in probate court yesterday. To the Cleveland Jewish Orphans' asylum he left \$1,000; to the Denver Jewish Home for Consumptives, \$1,000, and to the Temple Emanuel, of this city, another \$1,000.

Most of his property is left to his wife and relatives. Harry M. Levy has been appointed special administrator so that the business in which Mr. Zien was engaged will not be interrupted. The total value of the estate has not been ascertained.

Mr. Zien left a request in his will for the erection of a monument on his mother's grave in Russia and on his father's grave in Prussia.
