

BOY HIKERS CHASED BY A STATION AGENT

Fast progress is being made by the boys who are hiking to the Twin Cities, according to a postal received by friends in West Duluth yesterday. At the time of writing they had reached Hinckley, 75 miles from here, and expected to make St. Paul by the last of the week.

They report having had bad weather and very muddy roads, and that the rain has soaked them thoroughly. Their feet became sore on the second day out, so they took their shoes off, and have been walking barefooted. Monday evening, they took shelter in the station at Matawah but were driven out by the station agent. They then walked all night.
