

YOUNG WOMAN IS STRUCK BY AUTO

Miss Lillian Kaner of Superior Seriously Injured When Run Down by Car No. 2624

Automobile No. 2624 knocked down and seriously injured Lillian Kaner, a young woman, just above First street, on First avenue east yesterday afternoon. When the machine was stopped the girl was under the middle of it and had to be dragged out. The front wheels had passed one on each side of her body as she lay on the ground.

Miss Kaner was taken into the house at No. 106 First avenue east and a doctor was called. It was found that her left ankle was sprained and that she was bruised in several places. The automobile contained a woman and the chauffeur. As soon as the girl was taken into the house the people in the automobile rode away without giving any name or telling where they could be found.

Mrs. Williams, who lives upstairs at 106 First avenue east, saw the accident and says the woman in the automobile attempted to prevent her from obtaining the number of the machine. Dr. A. E. Walker, who was called, stated that Miss Kaner will not recover for a month or more.

Since automobile numbers are issued by the state the police have no record of them and last night they were still hunting for the owner of No. 2624.

The automobile was going up the avenue and was passing a wagon which was going east on First street. The wagon passed ahead of the auto. The girl was struck just as she stepped from the sidewalk. Miss Kaner lives in Superior but is employed in Duluth.
