

ALIENATION SUIT WILL BE COMMENCED TODAY

A suit for the alleged alienation of a wife's affection will be begun in district court this morning. The damages asked are \$25,000. The case is that of Joseph E. Fox against Albert H. Polinsky. In the complaint it is said that Fox married Lucile O. Hales, at Duluth, Dec. 12, 1904. They lived as husband and wife till June 25, 1909. In September of that year they were divorced. After the decision was given Mrs. Fox was arrested in a Superior hotel. Misconduct is affirmed against Polinsky and Mrs. Fox. Mental suffering and the loss of a home, is the ground on which Mr. Fox bases the claim for damages.
