

CRIMINAL CASES FOR TRIAL AT HIBBING

HIBBING, June 2.—The cases of the criminal calendar for the consideration of the district court section to be held in Hibbing, commencing June 6, are as follows: Sam Kacich is charged with murder in the first degree; he is alleged to have fought a fatal duel in Hibbing. Marino Stefano is charged with two offenses of assault in the first degree; it is alleged that he fired two shots at Dan Becco, Italian interpreter, and another man, W. Miller, by name. Two are charged with grand larceny—Louis Pederson is alleged to have taken 10 tons of hay from William Close, and H. Benesovitz is charged with having obtained jewelry under false pretenses.
