

FILING TIME COMES TO END

Many Candidates in Field for Various Offices—Several Filed Yesterday.

W. B. MOER IN FIELD FOR MUNICIPAL JUDGE

Contests for Number of Positions for Coming Primaries—The List of Candidates.

Yesterday marked the close for the filing of candidates for municipal offices, and the campaign will now be on in full blast until the primary election, Tuesday, Dec. 19.

The filing of W. B. Moer for municipal judge on the Democratic ticket to oppose the incumbent Judge William L.
