

FIRST MOVE IN CITY CAMPAIGN

Max Oreckovsky Officially Announces Candidacy for Alderman in Fourth Ward.

ALL ASPIRANTS MUST BE
IN FIELD BY NOV. 28

Mayor, Treasurer, Municipal
Judge and Others to
Be Elected.

The first move in the city political campaign started yesterday when Max Oreckovsky, a well known business man of the Fourth ward, filed for the Republican nomination for alderman. The contest is now on, and candidates will file for mayor, assessor, treasurer, municipal judge and aldermen in eight wards. The last day for filing is Nov. 28, and primary election falls on Dec. 19. The general election will be held in February.

Mr. Oreckovsky has grown up in Duluth, and is in a position to appreciate its needs. He says that one of the things that he will work for if nominated and elected, is a 5-cent fare with universal transfers for Park Pointers.

For the last few weeks Mr. Oreckovsky has been urged by voters of his ward to be an aldermanic candidate. He does not expect to meet with any opposition from Republicans of the Fourth ward.
