

I. L. LEVINE, AN OLD SETTLER, DIES

Was President of Kofereh Israel
Synagogue, and Well Known
Business Man.

Iankel L. Levine, 821 Fourth avenue east, a resident of Duluth for the last 27 years, and president of the Kofereh Israel synagogue for the last 20 years, who died yesterday morning at St. Mary's hospital, was buried yesterday afternoon in the Hebrew cemetery.
