

CHARGE SALE OF WEED TO MINORS

John Refset, Michael Grams and
A. Horwitz Are Ar-
rested.

BOY AND GIRL AID IN GETTING EVIDENCE

Warrants Out for Two Others in
Campaign to Stop This^r
Trade in Tobacco.

In an attempt to wipe out the selling of tobacco and cigaret papers to minors, John Refset, who operates a small store on one of the upper streets, Michael Grams, 810 Mesaba avenue and A. Horwitz, 326 East Sixth street, were arrested yesterday afternoon on the charge of selling tobacco to a nine year-old girl. Warrants are also out for F. Tarnowski and J. Flynn.

According to the mother of the little girl, there are a number of places in the city where the proprietors do not hesitate to sell tobacco in any form to any one, whether minors or girls. She reported some such sales and with the aid of the little girl obtained evidence. A ten-year-old boy was also employed in securing evidence.

All three men when brought into police court, pleaded not gully, and their hearings were set for 10 o'clock Friday morning. They were released on their own recognizance.
