

DRENKS BOOZE; THEN FIERY ACID

Abraham Levine, Michigan Street
Driver, Attempts Suicide.
Will Recover.

Rescued with life, Abraham Levine, a driver living at 1932 West Michigan street, after consuming whisky, attempted to commit suicide last night by drinking carbolic

acid. Firemen Monahan and Mason were called, and he was rushed to the hospital, where restoratives were administered. He will recover. He has a wife and three children, Rosa, 8 years old, Victor, 5 years old and Minnie, 1 year old. A warrant was sworn out against him last April on a charge of drunkenness, but was never served, as he returned home shortly afterwards.
