

# HITS LOST CUSTOMER'S NOSE; PAYS FINE IN COURT

Froeke Labovitz, proprietor of a second hand store on West Superior street, between Fifth and Sixth avenues west, was fined \$12.24 in police court yesterday morning by Judge Cutting on a disorderly conduct charge, preferred against him by Sievert Forland.

According to the complainant's story he went into the store to purchase a paper mache telescope. He asked the clerk the price and was told that it was half a dollar. Meanwhile Labovitz, the proprietor, came in, and upon being consulted by the clerk, stated that the price of the valise was 15 cents more than that before stated. Forland would not stand for this sudden raise in the price, he said, and started for the door, remarking, "Good morning and good bye."

He said that Labovitz came after him and upon being assured that he had lost a customer, took a "poke" at the retreating Forland. Complaint was made to the police.
