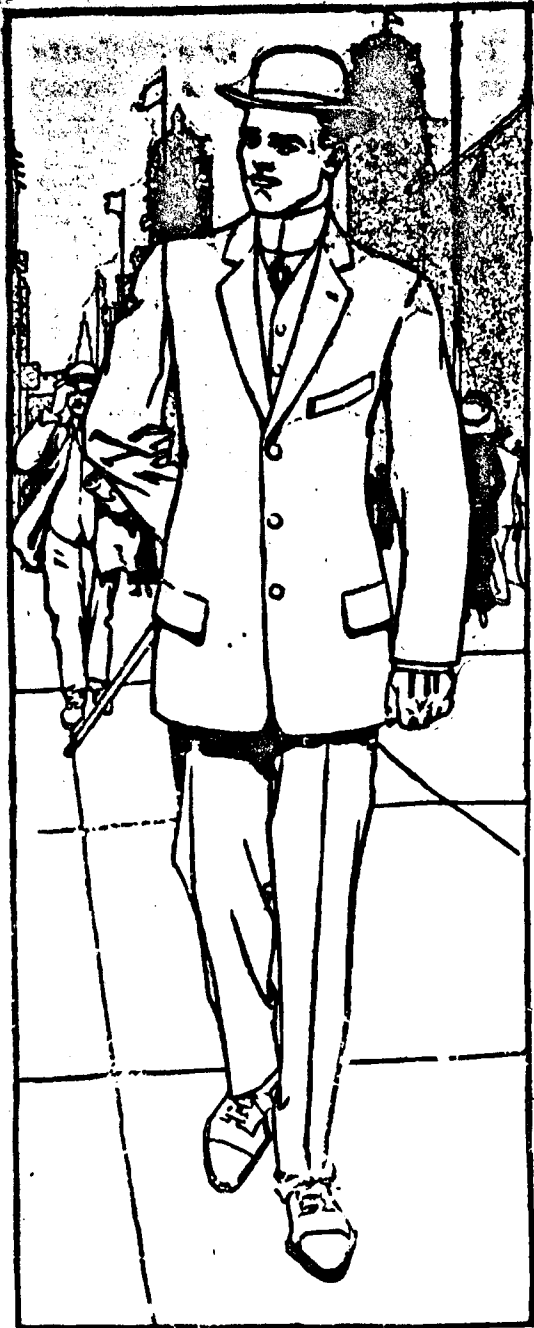

PLANS FOR ELK ENTERTAINMENT

LOCAL COMMITTEES ARE DOING SOME LIVELY HUSTLING FOR BIG STATE MEETING OF ELKS TO BE HELD IN FARGO JUNE 4 AND 5.

There was another enthusiastic meeting last night of the executive committee and chairman of the other committees who are planning to make the state convention of the Elks, June 4 and 5, a success. The air ship fights and the races will be entertaining features for the visitors. On the evening of June 4 there will be an automobile parade and June 5 there will be a parade of the Elks in which a number of grotesque features are to be given.

These meetings are to be held annually and under a plan adopted last year, they are to go in rotation to each lodge, according to seniority. This plan insures each lodge the opportunity of entertaining the state association and the money that would otherwise be spent in futile contests for the honor can now be given for the entertainment of the visitors.

One of the big features of the convention will be the music. Several bands have been engaged and some of the visiting lodges will also be accompanied by their own bands.

There will be elaborate decorations in Elk colors of all business houses and the streets and the entire city will be in gala attire when the anticipated boys come. Arrangements have been made with a large decorating concern in Chicago. All the decorations are set pieces and in fast colors that cannot be damaged by the weather conditions. These will be placed in position and taken down by the committee at prices cheaper than the firms could secure the material. It is also probable that the lamp posts along the white way will also be decorated—and there are to be streamers across the main streets.
