

HIBBING MERCHANTS FIGHT TRUANCY LAW

HIBBING, Oct. 3.—B. H. Edelstein, proprietor of a Center street furniture store, was arrested today by Truant Officer Booth, on a charge of violating the truancy law and his hearing has been set for Monday afternoon of next week. Edelstein is charged with keeping his daughter out of school.

He announces he will fight the case and has a right to keep his daughter out of school, to assist him while he is attending church.
