

EVELETH PASTOR AFTER SALOONS

Frank Rabinowitz Arrested on
Charge of Keeping Resort
Open on Sunday.

EVELETH, Dec. 2.—Frank Rabinowitz, a leading Eveleth saloon keeper, was arrested this morning on complaint of Rev. Philip A. Schwarz, who charged him with keeping his saloon open on Sunday. Rabinowitz was released on \$50 bail, and will be arraigned later.

Rabinowitz's arrest is said to be due to the determination of the good government element to force the saloons to obey the law. Mr. Schwarz asserts that most of the liquor men are beginning to realize that the law enforcers mean business and are keeping closed. It is said that with the exception of the man arrested the old was tight yesterday. Rabinowitz's place was raided two years ago, and he was fined \$50 and costs on the charge of allowing gambling.
