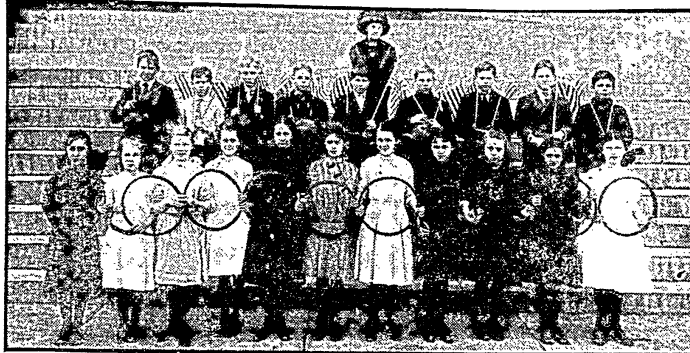


SCHOOL CHILDREN PARTICIPATE IN GYMNASTIC COSTUMED DRILLS

LESTER PARK SCHOOL, HOOP AND FLAG DRILL.



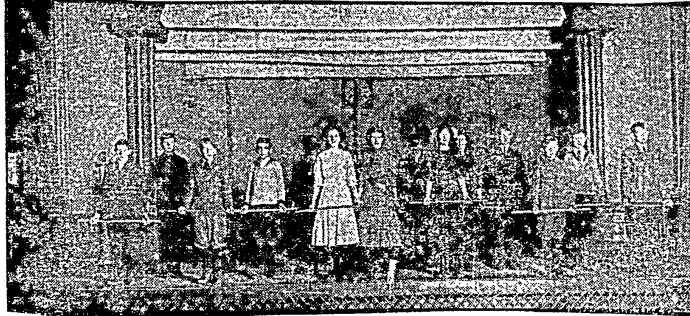

Drills, dances and exercises that were eye-openers to fathers and mothers and friends were given by the children of 21 schools on Thursday and Friday evenings at the Central high school assembly hall. M. E. Althaus, director of physical culture in the schools, has given the steps for the various exercises in the regular gymnastic work at the schools. The teachers or in some cases the principals took charge of the particular drill which was given, however, and of the costumes which played a large part in the effectiveness of the entertainers.

The more purely gymnastic numbers such as the club swinging, the dumb bell and wand exercises and the bean bag games were astonishingly well done and there was hardly a slip from beginning to end of these difficult numbers. The simple athletic costumes made these drills decidedly attractive to the eye. Then there were costume folk-dances, figures, drills and games ranging from the pretty broom-drills, good night and scarf drills by the smallest children to the flag and hoop drills, the minuets the French peasant dance and other effective numbers. 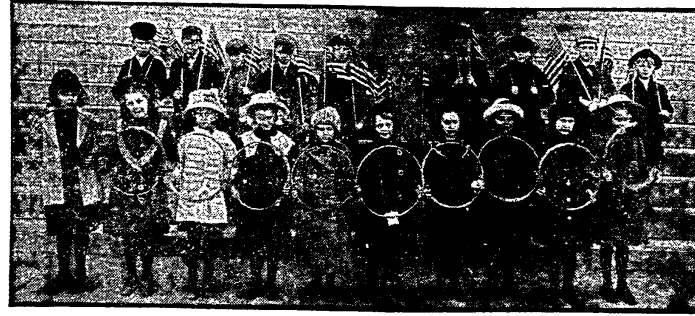

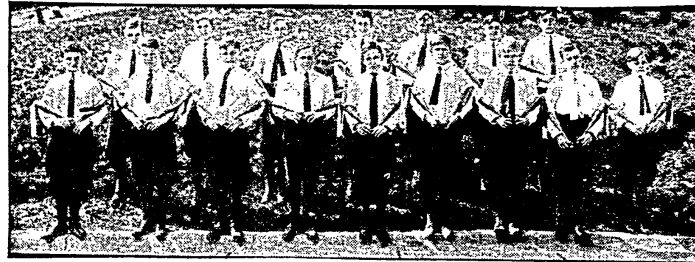
