

FIVE NARROWLY ESCAPE DEATH

Young Sons of M. Levine Awake
to Find House Filled With
Gas—Give Alarm.

NEIGHBORS RESPOND JUST
IN TIME TO SAVE LIVES

Mother and Daughter Leah Are
Unconscious When Dragged
From Their Beds.

Five members of the family of M. Levine, 722 East Third street, narrowly escaped death by asphyxiation early yesterday morning when a leak in a gaslight flooded the rooms with fumes. The fact that the windows in the sleeping apartments were open probably saved their lives.

The two youngest boys aged four and six years, respectively, were not affected and gave an alarm which brought neighbors to the house.

Mrs. Levine and her oldest daughter, Leah, were unconscious when carried from their beds. They were revived by the neighbors.
