

SOCIALISTS AFTER HIBBING OFFICES

HIBBING, Minn., Feb. 12.—A full set of candidates for village offices has been decided upon by the Socialist central body, with Don J. Rogers for president. Other candidates are: Treasurer, Oscar Bihlaja; recorder, Edward Grondahl; tustees, H. W. Riihonon, Ben Benesovitz and James Porteus.

The Socialists have also named Charles Erickson as a candidate for overseer of highways and will probably put a full ticket in the field for the township offices later.

Mr. Rogers, the candidate for mayor, was the Socialist candidate for that position last year. Oscar Bihlaja, candidate for treasurer, is a well-known local business man, and all the candidates are well known over the city. The Socialist vote last year for mayor was less than 200. It is expected this year to poll more than 300 votes and many are sanguine enough to believe the entire ticket will be elected. The campaign will be opened within the week.
